The purpose of Dress Rehearsal is for all of our performers to practice on the big stage before the show. Our goal is for Dress Rehearsal to run as closely to the actual performance as possible. We will do our best to remain on schedule. **Attendance is mandatory for all performers to be able to perform on Saturday, as stated upon sign-up.** 

<u>Check-In-</u> will be conducted in the lobby of the Stewart Center, where Loeb Playhouse is located. Staff & Volunteers will be there to escort your dancer backstage upon drop off. You will receive a performer ticket, which you will need for pick up! If purchasing photos, have your completed order form and payment ready to go!

<u>Check-Out-</u> after rehearsal slots and photos (order forms and info will go out separately) are taken, stage parents/ DMG Staff will bring them back to the lobby of the Stuart Center.

<u>Dancers and Stage Parents</u> will sit in the audience to watch the show before and after performing! To ease the load on our Stage Parents, no cover ups over costumes and please come with performance shoes on. If barefooted for routine, please drop off in slip on shoes. Please do not let your dancer wear their dance shoes outside ⊚

## **Rehearsal Safety Procedures:**

- ID tags will be given to one parent and dancer. You must have this tag in order to pick-up vour child.
- For the safety of your child, access through the theatre doors during Dress Rehearsal will be limited to volunteers and staff only.
- Stage Parents will be responsible for your child during their scheduled time block.
- Only volunteers and those with passes may enter the backstage area.
- ALL other access will be limited to the Stewart Center Lobby.

### Rehearsal Reminders:

- Dancers must arrive to rehearsal in full costume, make-up, hair and in proper dance shoes.
- Please make sure your child has eaten a proper meal prior to rehearsal for optimum energy, attention and performance. No food or drink backstage or in the audience.
- For the safety of our dancers, there will be **no flash photography or videotaping permitted inside the theatre during Dress Rehearsal and Recital.**
- Your child will not be excused from rehearsal until the end of their scheduled time block\* \*please be patient if we are running behind
